

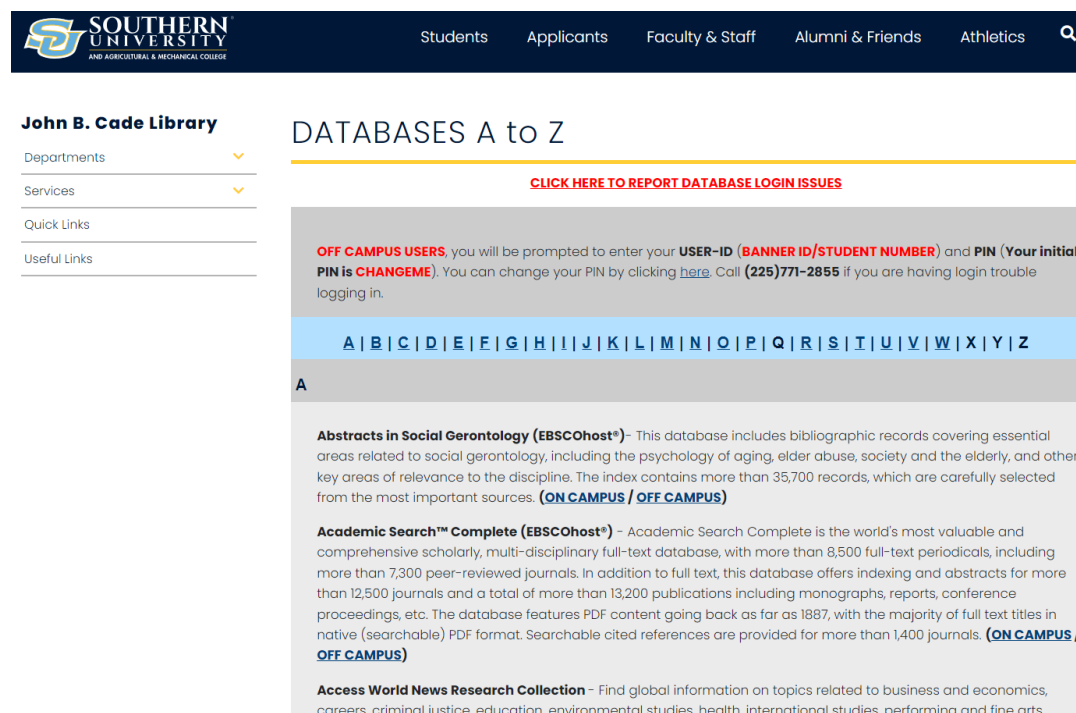
Databases and Scholarly Research
